Please read these Festival Rules carefully. By registering for the Festival, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to the Festival Rules.

Registration: All entries to be submitted online at www.northyorkmusicfestival.com no later than April 1, 2024. ("Virtual Registration Deadline"). Video recordings of the performance (and a copy of the score, if applicable) must be submitted with the registration. The detailed guidelines for submission are available on our website.

NYMF reserves the right to accept or reject any entry in its sole discretion.

Important: Once you register, we will not be able to switch your choice of participation from live festival to virtual and vice versa. You are welcome to register for both live and virtual options if you choose.

- 2. **Payment**: All fees are non-refundable, except where the entry is rejected. Administration fee is always not refundable. No receipts are issued. Late entries may be considered on case-by-case basis and are subject to a late fee of \$5/day.
- 3. **Adjudication:** Adjudicators' decisions are final and in their sole discretion. Each participant is judged based on the highest artistic standards with regard to musicianship, technical proficiency and stage performance. The Adjudicator reserves the right not to award any or all prizes. Parents, teachers, or participants may not approach the Adjudicator in person, via email or social media *at any time*; this may result in disqualification of the participant. NYMF reserves the right to substitute or appoint additional Adjudicators at any time at its sole discretion.
- 4. **Certificate Eligibility:** To be eligible to receive a certificate, the following minimum marks are required: 1st Place: 85%; 2nd Place: 80%; 3rd Place: 75%.

- 5. **Scholarship Eligibility:** Participants must compete in a minimum of 3 competitive classes in the same instrument to be eligible for a scholarship. Scholarships are awarded based on Adjudicator's marks and recommendations for competitors who display the most potential to develop musically in the future.
- 6. **Concerto Class Eligibility:** Participants must compete in a minimum of 2 competitive classes (not including the Concerto Class) to be eligible to participate in the Concerto Class. The winner(s) of the Concerto Class will perform with a Symphony Orchestra.
- Medals & Trophies: All participants who receive one 1st 7. Place certificate are eligible to receive a personalized medal. Those who obtain more than one 1st Place certificate are eligible to receive a personalized trophy instead of a medal. All scholarships, trophies and medals are presented at the Gala Concert to participants who confirm their attendance by purchasing Gala tickets in advance. Gala tickets are nonrefundable. Should a participant not be able to attend, special arrangements can be made to pick up the award after the Gala takes place. Please note: this option is available only to those participants who purchased Gala tickets. Some recipients of 1st Place certificates may be asked to perform at the Gala Concert. If requested, the participant shall perform on behalf of NYMF without a fee.
- 8. requirements **Performance** & programming procedure: Pieces in all graded competitive classes must be chosen from either the current Royal Conservatory of Music Syllabus, or Conservatory Canada Syllabus, except those marked "Own Choice". Participants are permitted to enter classes in different grades. Participants cannot perform the same piece in more than one class, except in Concerto and Provincial Qualifying classes. It is the participant's responsibility to be familiar with the Provincial Festival rules & repertoire requirements. NYMF assumes no responsibility for an entrant meeting or failing to meet these requirements. For information, please visit www.OMFA.info.

- 9. In age-based classes, the age is calculated as of January 1, 2024.
- 10. **Memorization is compulsory** for all competitive classes, unless otherwise indicated. Non-memorized performances will receive adjudication only. In non-competitive and ensemble classes, score may be used.
- 11. **Time limits** must be strictly observed; length of piece <u>must not exceed 15 minutes</u> unless otherwise specified. Please **omit all repeats** except D.C.
- 12. Students studying under the guidance of the Adjudicator must notify NYMF and will be placed with a different Adjudicator.

It is the sole responsibility of applicant to ensure correct class codes and timings are entered on the registration form. NYMF cannot assume responsibility or make adjustments for incorrectly entered classes.


